HAT TIP • • • <u>Harrison JACK Schmitt</u> (July 3, 1935–) is an American geologist, retired NASA astronaut, university professor, former U.S. senator from New Mexico, and the most recent living person—and only person without a background in military aviation—to have walked on the Moon.

In December 1972, as one of the crew onboard Apollo 17, Schmitt became the first member of NASA's first scientist-astronaut group to fly in space. As Apollo 17 was the last of the Apollo missions, he also became the twelfth and second-youngest person to set foot on the Moon and the second-to-last person to step off of the Moon (he boarded the Lunar Module shortly before commander Eugene Cernan.

Harrison and Gene Cernan assembled their lunar module on the moon's surface in their space suits. They drove abut 21 miles exploring more of the moon than ever before over 3 days with three different excursions.

Sadly, few people on planet earth paid attention in 1972... I in my 1st year of residency at Washington U (St. Louis) was one. 36hr "on" 12 hr "off".

• Astronaut Schmitt's Journey was on a SATURN V rocket designed by Wernher von Braun at a cost of 152 B. • it stood 363 feet (111 m) tall, and, ignoring the fins, was 33 feet (10 m) in diameter. Fully fueled, the Saturn V weighed 6.5 million pounds.

The SATURN V was moved to the launch sight on a flat top 'vehicle' called "The Crawler., this largest land vehicle ever made that moves on enormous treads That starts 3 ¹/₂ miles from the launchpad where the SATURN V was built on top of it. At the right time (hurricane free) The CRAWLER with SATURN V on top of moves down a special highway 30 feet deep designed to handle the strain of millions of pounds moving across it without shifting. The CRAWLER has locomotive-sized diesel engines that consume 165 gallons of fuel for every mile it travels at ¹/₂ mile per hour.
Once the SATURN V lifts off it hits a top speed of 25,000 mph

RHEUMATIC FEVER

RHEUMATIC FEVER (RF) is an inflammatory disease that can involve the heart, joints, skin, and brain. The disease typically develops two to four weeks after a <u>STREPTOCOCCAL THROAT INFECTION</u>.

Signs and symptoms include fever, multiple painful joints, involuntary muscle movements, and occasionally a characteristic non-itchy rash known as *erythema marginatum* [Bright pink or red circular lesions which have sharply-defined borders and faint central clearing. The lesions typically range from 3 to 10 cm in size, and are distributed symmetrically over the torso and inner surfaces of the limbs].

The heart is involved in about half of the cases.

Damage to the heart valves, known as **RHEUMATIC HEART DISEASE** (RHD), usually occurs after repeated attacks but can sometimes occur after one. The damaged valves may result in heart failure, atrial fibrillation and infection of the valves.

Rheumatic fever occurs in about 325,000 children each year and about 33.4 million people currently have rheumatic heart disease.

• is caused by an autoimmune reaction to Group A β -hemolytic streptococci (GAS) that results in valvular damage. Fibrosis and scarring of valve leaflets, commissures and cusps leads to abnormalities that can result in valve stenosis or regurgitation.

• If a patient develops heart failure due to valve disease, the patient should be placed on medical therapy as tolerated for heart failure including angiotensin-converting enzyme (ACE) inhibitors, diuretics, and beta-blockers.

• mitral regurgitation, aortic regurgitation, and Aortic Stenosis are common end diseases.

Prostate Meds Slash Dementia Risk by up to 40 Percent: Study

• Commonly prescribed alpha-blockers for treating benign prostatic hyperplasia may also offer protective effects against dementia with Lewy bodies.

• Researchers from the University of Iowa and the University of Michigan investigated whether three prostate drugs—terazosin, doxazosin, and alfuzosin—might offer protective effects against dementia with Lewy bodies.

• "We theorized that the increased energy in the cell may help prevent the build-up of certain harmful proteins in the brain associated with dementia with Lewy bodies," he said.

• The researchers analyzed data from more than 600,000 men who began treatment with one of the three prostate drugs or with two other types of prostate medications—tamsulosin and 5α -reductase inhibitors (5ARIs).

• The major side effect of concern is orthostatic hypotension

• The findings revealed that men taking terazosin, doxazosin, or alfuzosin had a significantly lower risk of developing LBD compared to those taking tamsulosin or 5ARIs. Specifically, the risk was 40 percent lower compared to tamsulosin and 37 percent lower compared to 5ARIs.

Researchers have found long-term evidence that actively monitoring localized prostate cancer is a <u>SAFE ALTERNATIVE TO IMMEDIATE SURGERY OR</u> <u>RADIATION</u>.

The results, released Saturday, are encouraging for men who want to avoid treatment-related sexual and incontinence problems, said Dr. Stacy Loeb, a prostate cancer specialist at NYU Langone Health who was not involved in the research.

The study directly compared the <u>THREE APPROACHES</u>—surgery to remove tumors,

radiation treatment,

and monitoring.

Most prostate cancer grows slowly, so it takes many years to look at the disease's outcomes.

"There was no difference in prostate cancer mortality at 15 years between the groups," Loeb said.

And prostate cancer survival for all three groups was high—97 percent regardless of treatment approach. "That's also very good news."

The results were published Saturday in the New England Journal of Medicine and presented at a European Association of Urology conference in Milan, Italy. Britain's National Institute for Health and Care Research paid for the research.

Men diagnosed with **LOCALIZED PROSTATE CANCER** shouldn't panic or rush treatment decisions, said lead author Dr. Freddie Hamdy of the University of Oxford.

• Instead, they should "consider carefully the possible benefits and harms caused by the treatment options."

- A small number of men with high-risk or **MORE ADVANCED DISEASE** do need urgent treatments, he added.
- Researchers followed more than 1,600 UK men who agreed to be randomly assigned to get surgery, radiation, or active monitoring.

The patients' cancer was confined to the prostate, a walnut-sized gland that's part of the reproductive system.

• Men in the monitoring group had regular blood tests and some went on to have surgery or radiation.

• Death from prostate cancer occurred in 3.1 percent of the activemonitoring group,

2.2 percent in the surgery group, and

2.9 percent in the radiation group, differences considered statistically insignificant.

• At 15 years, cancer had spread in 9.4 percent of the active-monitoring group,

4.7 percent of the surgery group and 5 percent of the radiation group.

The study was started in 1999, and experts said today's monitoring practices are better, with MRI imaging and gene tests guiding decisions.

"We have more ways now to help catch that the disease is progressing before it spreads," Loeb said. In the United States, about 60 percent of low-risk patients

<u>CHOOSE MONITORING</u>, now called active surveillance.

Hamdy said the researchers had seen the difference in cancer spread at 10 years and expected it to make a difference in survival at 15 years, "but it did not." He said spread alone doesn't predict prostate cancer death.

"This is a new and interesting finding, useful for men when they make decisions about treatments," he said.

New shingles vaccine could cut dementia risk by 25 per cent, Oxford research suggests...but scientists still aren't sure why

A shingles vaccine, available on the NHS, could reduce the risk of dementia by up to 27 per cent compared to jabs for other illnesses, a study shows.

The painful and serious condition, which mainly affects older people, can cause an uncomfortable rash and lead to serious problems such as deafness, long-lasting pain and even blindness.

In 2021, a vaccine called Shingrix was introduced on the NHS, replacing a previous jab for shingles called Zostavax.

And now, a major study has shown Shingrix is linked to a 'significantly' lower risk of dementia compared to Zostavax and jabs for other illnesses, which have also shown to reduce the risk of developing the condition.

• Researchers from the University of Oxford analyzed data on more than 200,000 people in the USA, where the Shingrix vaccine has been used for longer.

• Over six years, the team found Shingrix was linked with a 17 per cent lower risk of dementia than the previously-used Zostavax, with women benefitting more than men. However, when compared to people who had just received vaccines against other infections such as flu and tetanus, those who received Shingrix had a 23-27 per cent lower risk of developing dementia.

• Dr Maxime Taquet, academic clinical lecturer in the department of psychiatry at Oxford, who led the study, said: 'The size and nature of this study makes these findings convincing and should motivate further research.

'They support the hypothesis that vaccination against shingles might prevent dementia.
